

**RESOLUTION NO. 2025-12-XXXX**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
SIGNAL HILL, CALIFORNIA, IMPLEMENTING  
OVERNIGHT PARKING RESTRICTIONS BETWEEN THE  
HOURS OF 10:00 P.M. AND 5:00 A.M. ON GUNDRY  
AVENUE FROM 2111 GUNDRY AVENUE TO 21ST  
STREET AND ON 21ST STREET FROM GUNDRY AVENUE  
TO WALNUT AVENUE**

**WHEREAS**, reports have been filed with the City of Signal Hill (“City”) Police Department by City residents and local businesses regarding public nuisances including excess noise, littering, and other illegal activities stemming from parked recreational, commercial, or non-resident passenger vehicles on a segment of Gundry Avenue and one block of 21<sup>st</sup> Street shown on Exhibit “A” attached hereto and incorporated by reference in to this Resolution; and

**WHEREAS**, the aforementioned vehicles have been observed by the Police Department and others to park at night for consecutive days, and create nuisances for nearby properties and business during nighttime hours; and

**WHEREAS**, such vehicles have also reportedly remained parked for extended periods of time in violation of Signal Hill Municipal Code Section 10.28.050; and

**WHEREAS**, because of the foregoing concerns, the City Police Department has requested the implementation of overnight parking restrictions on a specified segment of Gundry Avenue and one block of 21st Street as shown on Exhibit “A”; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Vehicle Code section 22507 and SHMC § 10.28.150(A), the City, may by resolution, prohibit or restrict parking or standing vehicles on any street within the City, or any portion thereof during all or certain hours of the day; and

**WHEREAS**, during its June 25, 2025, meeting, the City's Traffic Safety Committee reviewed the proposed parking restriction requests for compliance with applicable codes and regulations and made a recommendation to implement no overnight parking restrictions as an appropriate solution to address the noted concerns on a specified segment of Gundry Avenue and one block of 21st Street as shown on Exhibit "A".

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SIGNAL HILL, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. Recitals. The above recitals are true and correct and hereby incorporated into this Resolution.

Section 2. No overnight parking is hereby implemented on the easterly and westerly curbs of Gundry Avenue starting from the intersection at 21st, then ending 285 feet north at the northerly property line of 2111 Gundry Avenue in the City of Signal Hill, as shown in Exhibit "A" of this Resolution. The foregoing tow-away no parking restrictions are in place between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m., every day of the week.

Section 3. No overnight parking is hereby implemented on the northerly curb of 21<sup>st</sup> Street from Gundry Avenue to the intersection at Walnut Avenue in the City of Signal Hill as shown on Exhibit "A" of this Resolution. The foregoing tow-away parking restrictions are in place between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m., every day of the week.

Section 4. The City's Public Works Department shall install appropriate signage on Gundry Avenue and 21<sup>st</sup> Street, reflecting the updated overnight parking restrictions implemented via Sections 2 and 3 of this Resolution.

Section 5. The City Clerk shall attest and certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions, and it shall become effective immediately upon its approval.
